The Federal Government (FNG) has received a grant from the European Union for the implementation of the small Towns Water Supply and Sanitation Programme (STWSSP) pilot projects. The pilot project are being implemented in three (3) States (Adamawa, Delta and Ekiti)

2. Federal Ministry of Agriculture and Water Resources under the Appropriation Act of 2008 wishes to procure the services of:

Lot 1: Monitoring and Evaluation Consultant- to develop participatory Monitoring and Evaluation tools as well as test run the tools at community level. In addition the consultant will supervise and participate in developing training programmes for monitoring and evaluation in collaboration with the NWRI for all levels of the project implementation.

Lot 2: Media Consultant to formulate and develop drama/play S, TV and Radio enlightenment programmes/jingles on the objectives STWSSP, production of documentary of the pilot projects and assists in the production of quarterly Newsletter and flyers for STWSSP in accordance with EU Visibility Guidelines

The implementation period of both assignments will for one year.

3. The Federal Ministry of Agriculture and Water Resources now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the above services. Each of the above mentioned Lots will form a separate contract.
